Congratulations on the following new grants awarded this month!

Olivia Wackowski received a new R01 from the National Institutes on Minority Health and Health Disparities, along with Dana Carroll (contact PI) at the University of Minnesota, titled “Evaluating Population-Based Strategies for Rural Smoking Cessation” (R01MD020559). The timeline for this project is March 1, 2025 - November 30, 2029.

Michelle Bover Manderski and Ollie Ganz received a 12 month, \$400,000 award from the NIH-FDA Opportunity Fund entitled “A Multi-Method Study Examining Age Differences in ENDS Use Behaviors Among Adults Who Smoke Cigarettes.” The NIH-FDA Opportunity Fund is a competitive mechanism to fund FDA high priority rapid research and is administered through CASEL (U54DA046060). The timeline for this project is May 1, 2025 - April 30, 2026.
